

THE FOUR LEVELS OF FIBAA VALUE CREATION

FIBAA operates on the basis of a clearly structured set of rules and procedures that include various levels with defined roles and responsibilities. These four bodies – the Foundation Council, the Accreditation and Certification Commission, the expert reviewers, and the Head Office – together ensure the high quality and transparency of our accreditation and certification procedures.



FOUNDATION BOARD - STRATEGIC BODY

The FIBAA Foundation Board is the highest governing body of the foundation and is responsible for its long-term direction and core values. Core tasks:

- Defining the normative and strategic guidelines
- Promoting quality, transparency, and internationality in higher education
- Monitoring compliance with the foundation's goals and principles

FIBAA ACCREDITATION AND CERTIFICATION COMMITTEE (F-ACC) – DECISION-MAKING BODY

The F-ACC ensures the quality assurance and further development of educational offerings. Core tasks:

- Development and continuous improvement of quality standards
- Evaluation of academic quality at both programme and institutional level
- Decision-making on accreditations and certifications
- Monitoring and assessment of innovative developments in the higher education sector

EXPERTS – EVALUATIVE BODY

The experts are independent professionals who provide well-founded evaluations of study programmes and institutions. Core tasks:

- Analysis of documentation submitted by higher education institutions
- Conducting on-site evaluations
- Preparing objective expert reports with recommendations for action
- Independent, impartial assessment without representing personal interests

OFFICE – EXECUTIVE BODY

The Office is the operational force behind the procedures and ensures their smooth implementation. Core tasks:

- Organisation and coordination of accreditation and certification procedures
- Communication with higher education institutions, reviewers, and commissions
- Support for reviewers and administrative assistance
- Ensuring timely processing and documentation
